

**FARLEY CHURCH OF CHRIST**  
**FACILITY USE POLICY**

The Church building of The Farley Church of Christ and the property surrounding that building (herein referred to "facilities") are considered "Private Property" and are not open to the public or available for public use, e.g., by rental.

If an individual or group wishes to use the Farley Church of Christ facilities for an event not directly related to our Mission, that event must be sponsored by AND attended by a member of the Farley Church.

The member of the Farley Church who agrees to sponsor AND attend an event not directly related to our Mission but desiring to use Farley's facilities must also agree to be held financially liable for the condition of the facilities following that event, i.e., Farley's facilities be returned to a condition acceptable to the church.

Regardless of position of the individual agreeing to sponsor AND attend an event not directly related to our Mission, Farley's facilities may not under any circumstance be used by a person or group holding, advancing, or advocating beliefs or practices that violate Farley's faith and moral teachings (which are enumerated in our Statements of Mission, Purpose and Faith or the Bible itself). The Elders and or Minister have the final decision-making authority concerning the use of Farley's facilities.

Using the documents above and the Bible as our guides, the Farley Church of Christ will require those who use (or visit) our facilities to abide by the principles of both decency and decorum.

The following rules will apply to the use of Farley's facilities:

- Permission from the Elders and or Minister must be obtained to use Farley's building and/or property.
- This form must be signed by the party requesting to use Farley's building and/or property and by an elder or preacher of the Farley Church of Christ.

This Facility Use Policy is necessary for two reasons:

- Farley cannot in good conscience materially support or promote activities or beliefs that violate our faith and moral teachings. Allowing Farley's facilities to be used for a purpose that violates our faith and moral teachings would be to support that purpose. This would be a serious violation of Farley's faith and religious practice (II Cor. 6:14; 1Thess. 5:22).
- It is important that Farley present a consistent message to the community we serve and that the Elders and Ministers consistently maintain that message as part of our testimony to the teachings of Christ. Allowing Farley's facilities to be used by persons or groups who express beliefs or engage in practices contrary to our faith and moral teachings would have a severe and negative impact on the message that we strive to consistently promote.
